


FREE TEXTBOOKS

DEAR STUDENT, DEAR PARENTS

Since the 2018/2019 school year, mandatory textbooks have been free for students in secondary education and vocational training. The government thus provides financial relief for all families, up to 450 euros per school year and per child, depending on the class and type of education. We are strengthening free education along with the already existent free offer in elementary education.

An online application with a personalised, secure access will enable students to select their text-books, which can then be picked up in bookstores, without having to pay for them.

We also want to encourage the sustainable and responsible use of textbooks. If you use second-hand books, you'll be rewarded with a voucher to buy other books up to 50% of the value of the unselected new textbooks.

Free mandatory textbooks have no impact on the school start allowance or any other financial aid. It's a net benefit for your family.
